

Mindanao State University -General Santos (MSU-GSĆ) is embarking on an exciting and promising venture as it has received approval to launch and operate a Technology Business Incubator (TBI) dedicated to nurturing startups in Region XII. This significant development was realized through a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed during the 6th TBI Summit as part of the Philippine Startup Week, which took place at the Blue Leaf **Events Pavilion in Taguig City** on November 16, 2022.

In this endeavor, MSU-GSC joined forces with 15 other Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) under the Readiness for Innovation and Technopreneurship - 2.0 program. The MOA was established in collaboration with the Department of

Science and Technology Philippine Council for Industry, Energy, and Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST PCIEERD).

This MOA signing ceremony marked the highlight of the event and set the stage for the institution to receive essential funding for the establishment of a Technology Business Incubator in the region. The initiative falls under the purview of the "Handholding tarting Incubators from HEIš for Readiness towards Innovation and Technopreneurship Preparatory and Skills Acceleration for TBI Managers Optimizing Regional Startup Ecosystem (HIHEIRIT PA MORE!)" program. This program is poised to drive innovation and technology entrepreneurship in Region XII and promises to be a gamechanger for aspiring entrepreneurs and startups.

The MOA signing event was graciously spearheaded by Dr. Mishell D. Lawas, the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (VCAA) at MSU-GSC. It was attended by key project members who played pivotal roles in mäking this collaboration a reality. These distinguished individuals include Dr. Noel S. Gunay, Dr. Marissa G. Dela Cruz, Dr. Ryan G. Banal, Dr. Jypzie M. Catedrilla, Dr. Cristina P. Dadula, and Bretch Guire C. Garcinez, MSc. 
One of the major challenges of starting an entrepreneurial endeavor is conforming to policies of the city. With the partnership with the Local Government Unit of General Santos - City Economic Management and Cooperative Development Office (CEMCDO), and Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (POPHL) - Bureau of Copyright and other Related Rights (BCRR), experts from the industry and regulators from the local government talked about the process, the requirements, and the challenges of applying for business name and permit.

Erika Mae A. Espejo, ICEBOX TBI Manager welcomed all the participants to the event and conveyed the rationale of the event, which is primarily to aid the ICEBOX Incubatees: Eva, Funnel for Biz, Legalease, Pastille, and Serbees. Sharon Faith B. Medecilo, Trade and Industry Development

Specialist from the Department of Trade and Industry gave a talk about the services of their office and the process of applying for a Business Name. On the other hand, Engr. Rein Amoro, represented the City Planning and Development Office and shared how building permit is processed and the considerations set thereof by their office. To end the series of discussion, Troy Torrecampo, Development Management Officer of CEMCDO gave the talk about the contribution of startups and entrepreneurs in propelling the competitive index of the city as one of its indicators.

Afterwards, a consultation with the speakers and Julee Ann Templado, Administrative Aide from the CEMCDO were held to address the concerns of the entrepreneurs and startups. This platform allowed them to directly tailor their questions to their context and gain insights how to address the problem they encounter.
